




# **ELMS Help**

# **ELMS Help: Topics**

## Layout

Every Help Topic has the same layout:

#### Overview

— The description of the ELMS Page and the task(s) to be accomplished.

### Navigation

— The menu, menu item(s), and / or buttons to use to get to the page within ELMS.

### Page Fields

— A list of field names that link to their definitions. Also whether or not the field is mandatory.

#### Procedures

— A list of tasks to accomplish, with step-by-step instructions for each one.

#### Common Errors

— A list of errors that can appear on that page, along with the definition of the error, and how to fix it.


### Related Topics

— A list of additional help topics that link to other pages, and can give further insight and instructions for the ELMS Module Page.


## Search the Help System
