



Search for an Asset Transfer — Criteria

Overview

The Property Accountability module Asset Transfer process provides the ability to transfer an end item or component record (Serial or Bulk) to another Property Custodian within the same UIC, UIC-to-UIC, or SITE ID-to-SITE ID.

If a serial record has components, the Transfer process looks for the Stock Number on the gaining Catalog. If one does not exist, the Transfer process inserts the Stock Number of the component on the losing Catalog. If the manufacturer information does not exist on the gaining Catalog, the Transfer process inserts the manufacturer information of the component from the losing Catalog.

During the Transfer process, users have the capability to designate assets for a Pending Transfer. If the user does not have Security access to the gaining portion of the transaction, the assets are automatically designated as Pending.

Attention



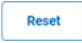
Use the Both (Non-Capital and Capital) radio button only if all assets being transferred. Do not use the **Defense Agencies Initiative (DAI)** Accounting System Interface. For DAI, Non-Capital and Capital assets should be transferred in separate transactions.

Helpful Tip



When an asset is transferred between UICs, it goes from one custodian to another custodian in a different UIC. The originator of the transfer is referred to as the Losing side and the receiving Site, UIC or Custodian is referred to as the Gaining side.

For example, if an asset is transferred from UIC HQ0001 to UIC HQ0002, then UIC HQ0001 is the Losing side and UIC HQ0002 is the Gaining side.

Attention



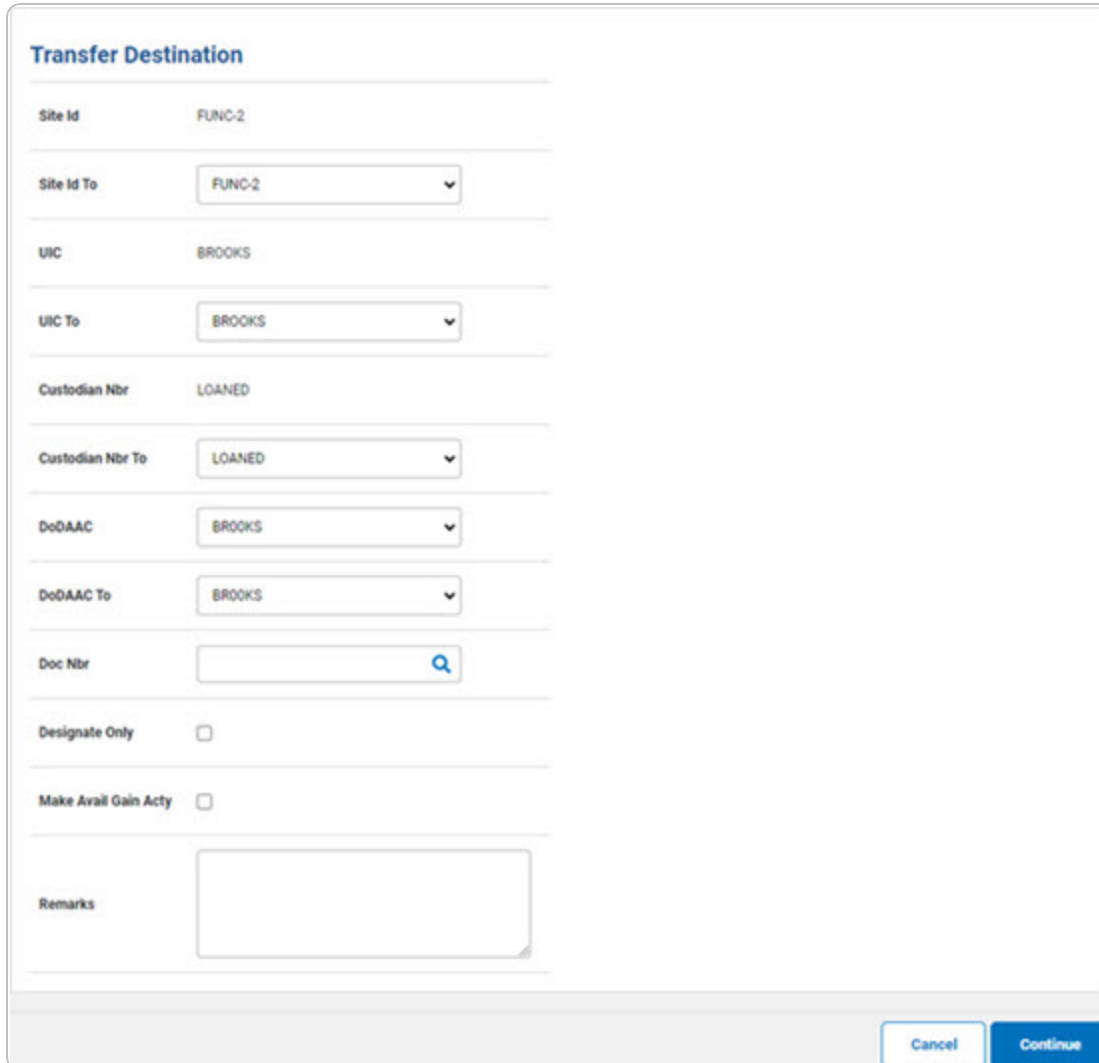
It is recommended to not select the **Custodian Nbr To**. If the **Custodian Nbr To** is selected, the gaining side will not be able to change it when they complete the Transfer. Transfer action is not authorized for asset(s) other than LOAN CD "G".
