



Search for a MAINT GROUP ID — Criteria

Overview

The Property Accountability module MAINT GROUP ID process provides the ability to identify assets for maintenance or utilization. When a new stock number is cataloged, the cataloger must associate a Maintenance Group with the Stock Number. Since the Maintenance Group is associated a Stock Number, the Maintenance Groups must be maintained at the Catalog Name level (a set of Maintenance Groups/Catalog).

Maintenance Groups are subsequently associated with a UIC and Maintenance Activity or to a UIC and External Maintenance Interface. This allows for identifying what activity is providing maintenance or utilization management for the assets that are associated with the Stock Number with a particular Maintenance Group.



Procedures

Search for a MAINT GROUP ID — Criteria

One or more of the Search Criteria fields can be entered to isolate the results. By default, all results are displayed. Selecting at any point of this procedure returns all fields to the default "All" setting.

1. In the Search Criteria panel, narrow the results by entering one or more of the following optional fields.







- Use to select the Catalog.
- Enter the Maint Grp Desc in the field provided. This is a 25 alphanumeric character field.

Helpful Tip

A wild card is permitted using the percentage (%) sign when performing a search. Example: MAINT GRP ID of Maint% will find all MAINTENANCE GROUP IDS beginning with the word Maint.

2. Select Search Results of the Maint Group Id Search Results page appears. Results display in the Search Results grid.



Add a MAINT GROUP ID

Selecting at any point of this procedure removes all revisions and closes the page. **Bold** numbered steps are required.

1. Select . The MAINT GROUP ID Add page appears.



- **A.** Enter the MAINT GRP ID in the field provided. This is a 2 alphanumeric character field.
- **B.** The Catalog automatically updates and is not editable.
- **C.** Enter the Maint GRP Desc in the field provided. *This is a 25 alphanumeric character field.*
- 2. Select . The **Maint Group Id Transaction Status** page appears.



Procedures

Update a MAINT GRP ID

Selecting at any point of this procedure removes all revisions and closes the page. **Bold** numbered steps are required.

1. Select the Update hyperlink. The **MAINT GRP ID Update** page appears.



- **A.** Update the Maint Grp ID, entering the revised identifier in the field provided. *This is a 2 alphanumeric character field.*
- **B.** Verify the Catalog.
- **C.** Update the Maint Grp Desc, entering the revised description in the field provided. *This is a 25 alphanumeric character field.*
- 2. Select Update . The Maint Group Id Transaction Status page appears.



- **C.** Verify the MAINT GRP DESC.
