





Create a Pick Plan

Procedures

Create a Pick Plan


One or more of the Search Criteria fields can be entered to isolate the results. By default, all results are displayed. Selecting  at any point of this procedure returns all fields to the default "All" setting.

1. Select ☐ next to the desired request.
2. Select  Pick ▼. The Pick Menu appears.
3. Select . The **Create Pick Plan** pop-up window appears.








