





# Install Application

1. Open your Google Chrome browser.
2. Login in to either DPAS Property Accountability or Warehouse module
3. Navigate to **AIT > Physical Inventory** – An install prompt will appear.
4. Expand the notification and select **Install**.


To expedite the installation process, scan this QR Code and skip to step 4.





## Install Application cont'd

5. If the notification does not appear, the option may be located using the dropdown menu.



If you do not see the install prompt:

- Allow the page to load completely
- Using the menu, Navigate to [...] > Settings > Privacy and security > Clear browsing data
- On both Basic and Advance tabs, clear Data
- Refresh the page

If the install prompt does not appear, ensure settings managed by your organization are not restricting the required extension

6. Once the install is complete, a shortcut will appear on the home screen of the device.

7. Find and select the shortcut to launch the application.

8. The application will launch in a new window, and is now able to be ran offline.






## Uninstall from Google Chrome

1. To uninstall Google Chrome browser, open the browser.
2. Expand the menu at the top of the application.
3. Select **Uninstall DPAS – Inventory** – the **Remove DPAS – Inventory** pop-up window appears.

### OS/Browser/Hardware Considerations

- If you are using anything other than Win10 device or Chrome browser, the install steps may vary.

4. If you want to clear the data from Chrome, select the Checkbox for this option.
5. Select the **Remove** button to complete the process – the application is uninstalled and the shortcut is removed from the home screen.
