



Adding Project Code Ranges

1. In the DPAS Warehouse Management module, navigate to **Project Cd Range** from the **Warehouse Mgmt** menu - The **Project Cd Range** page displays with all available ranges visible in the Results Grid.
2. Select the **Add** button – The **Add Project Code Range** pop-up displays.
3. Enter an alphanumeric value in the **1st Position** field.
4. Select one of the available values (Alpha, Numeric, or Alpha-Numeric) from the **2nd Position** drop-down list.
5. Select one of the available values (Alpha, Numeric, or Alpha-Numeric) from the **3rd Position** drop-down list.
6. Enter the last assigned project code in the **Last Prj Cd Assigned** field - The Project Cd must match the defined format.
7. Enter a description of the Project Code Range in the **Desc** (Description) field.
8. Select the **Add** button – The Project Code Range displays in the Results Grid.

Project Codes are used to identify a specific project for a Warehouse. The Project Code is defined using three alphanumeric fields. Each of the three fields may be assigned individually as alpha or numeric (A-Z or 0-9).

Once a value has been used for the first position it cannot be used to define another Project Code Range for the current Warehouse.
