Release 3.1.01 for the Defense Property Accountability System (DPAS) was released on August 26, 2015. This release corrects program deficiencies identified by the user community and through testing by the development teams. There is no action required by the user to receive the update.

Property Accountability Module:

This release contains the following Help Tickets:

Generate DD 1150 Request for Issue or Turn In

- WPHRN64 - Generate DD 1150 Request for Issue or Turn In
 - o Corrected a deficiency which caused the user to be unable to generate a DD 1150 form when using the Mass Upload option. The Program ID for spreadsheet upload when receiving via the spreadsheet was not listed, so it would not create the form. Adding the Program ID now allows the forms to be created. (Help Ticket #1027, #1076, #2695, #2887, #3041).

Real Property AUD

- WPACN11 - Real Property AUD
 - o Corrected a deficiency that caused the user to be unable to locate Real Property installation on Wake Island (Help Ticket #2626).

Reports/Inquiries

- WPGLO01 - Data Inquiry Extract
 - o Corrected a deficiency that caused the user to be unable to download the .EXE for the requested data inquiry extract. The process was updated to download the requested data as a .ZIP file instead of a .EXE file (Help Ticket #3144).

Update Inventory Data

- WPHRN05 - Update Inventory Data
 - o Corrected a deficiency which caused the previous Agency-Defined field values on assets to be overwritten with invalid, code-based values when updating one or more asset records in the Update Inventory program. In addition, scripts have been run to revert the Agency-Defined field values back to their previous, valid values (Help Ticket #2967).

Warehouse Management Module:

This release contains the following Help Tickets:

Location AUD

- LPWHN07 - Location AUD
 - Corrected a deficiency where the check for a single Individual Issue Location default for a Stock Number was not including the Warehouse, so any Stock Numbers that already had a Individual Issue Location set up in one Warehouse could not have an Individual Issue Location set up in another related Warehouse. (Help Ticket #2928)

Warehouse Transfer

- LPWHN43 - Warehouse Transfer
 - Corrected a deficiency which caused the user to receive a validation message stating the item's Condition Code was invalid while attempting to ship a Warehouse Transfer. (Help Ticket #2952)

Quality Control

- LPWHN56 - Quality Control
 - Corrected a deficiency which caused the user to receive a validation message while attempting to update a Serial Kit from the Serial Kit Update screen. A message stated the current kit has allocations against it in the Quality Control process. (Help Ticket #3012).

Receiving

- LWPHN19 - Receiving
 - Corrected a deficiency which caused the user to receive a validation message while attempting to complete an already verified Receiving document. This validation message was caused by the client side conversion from Eastern Standard Time to the users local timezone. (Help Ticket #2668)

Individual Issue

- LPWHN32.1 - Individual Issue
 - Corrected a deficiency which caused a Member's prior Issued items to reflect Stock Numbers that were not actually Issued. (Help Ticket #2987).

Individual Returns

- LPWHN46.1 - Individual Returns
 - Corrected an issue where upon setting items to "Not Returned" would not send all the necessary data to the server. (Help Ticket #3126)

Unit Returns

- LPWHN47 - Unit Returns

- o Corrected a deficiency where a user could not return a Serialized Kit after validating it. This problem was resolved by having the ICNs sent to the Pending tab for the user to verify. (Help Ticket #3124).
