Templates/Attributes



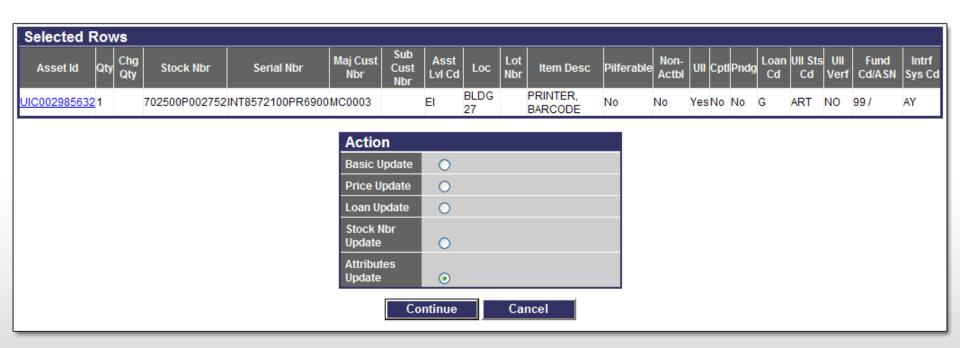
- Attributes are characteristics or specifications for assets placed in a template.
- Examples of attributes:
 - Laptop attributes may include: size, weight, processor, USB ports and operating system.
 - Vehicle attributes may include: color, doors, tire size, number of axles and engine size.
- A template can only belong to one Asset Control Code (ACC). For example, the template for a printer is only available for the ACC of K-IT Equipment/Hardware.
- Attributes are associated to assets by using the Asset Update process.



- Attributes can only be associated with serial assets and components; they cannot be associated to bulk, real property or improvements assets.
- The use of templates and attributes are optional.
- New attribute templates are created at the Application Administrator level ONLY. If you would like a new template added, or attributes added to an existing template, contact your Agency Coordinator.
- A template may contain up to 100 attributes.
- Some agencies use Agency Defined fields for asset descriptions such as Unclassified and Classified. The use of attributes may alleviate some of these types of Agency Defined fields, and make them available for other use.







From the **Asset Update Selected Rows** page, you select a new radio button called **Attributes Update.**



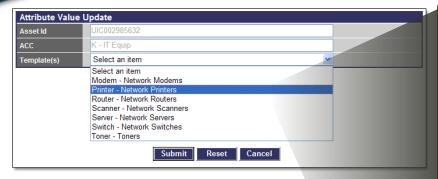




On the **Asset Update** page, you select the white **Action** button next to the **Attributes (s)** field.



Templates/Attributes



On the Asset Value Update page, you select a template from the Template(s) dropdown. Once the attributes available in the template display, you enter values in those attributes you wish to use.







The selected attributes are listed below the **Attributes (s)** field.

 Stock Number Mass Update – If a Stock Number is changed to a Stock Number with the same ACC, the attributes will remain with the asset. However, if a Stock Number is changed to a Stock Number with a different ACC, the attribute association will be deleted. The appropriate message will be displayed.





- Asset Transfer Added additional logic to handle Attribute changes.
- Attribute Add/Update/Delete- New process added to allow the Administrative Users of DPAS to configure and maintain the possible attributes of Assets.
- Template Add/Update/Delete New process added to allow the Administrative Users of DPAS to configure and maintain the attribute templates for each ACC.







The Asset Inquiry now includes attributes information added to assets.



Authorizations



Authorizations Updates

The ability to authorize by LIN/TAMCN was implemented in release 2.2. In 2.3, now there is additional functionality to add attachments. There is also a new browse and three new reports to support LIN/TAMCN.

- Authorization (LIN/TAMCN) Add/Update/Delete Added the capability to add or remove Attachments.
- New LIN/TAMCN Authorization Report Includes quantities (authorized, required, onhand, due in, and over/under), effective and expiration dates, document number, and property type.
- New Asset Summary Report which includes the SB700-20 Army changes and acquisition cost information.
- LIN/TAMCN Authorization Browse Modified the browse to retrieve Authorization for all UICs for an Accountable UIC when more than one UIC exists for the LIN/TAMCN Authorization.



Unique Item Tracking (UIT)



Unique Item Tracking (UIT) processes were updated to support Substitution transactions, which were also included in Legacy DPAS reports. Substitution transactions represent assets where their Catalog LIN/TAMCN does not match the Authorization LIN/TAMCN.

- **UIT Interface Transaction Report –**Added the Substitution information and includes a Negative Reports area for UIC's with no changes since the last time it was reported.
- UIT Reconciliation Report This new report is generated during the semi-annual UIT Recon or the UIT Out-Of-Cycle Recon processes. It displays all UIT Reportable Assets by UIC.
 Substitute and Negative records are included in the report.
- **UIT Out of Cycle Recon Request –** The process will generate a batch record for each UIT Reportable UIC selected on the screen. The regular UIT Recon will then process the batch record(s) and generate a UIT Recon for specific UICs. A UIT file will be created and sent to the Logistics Support Activity (LOGSA). Users will need to get prior approval from LOGSA to run an Out-Of-Cycle reconciliation. Currently, this process is located under the Asset Management menu selection in DPAS.
- **New UIT Substitution Reconciliation capability.** It will write a substitution record if the Catalog LIN/TAMCN is different from the Authorization LIN/TAMCN (background).

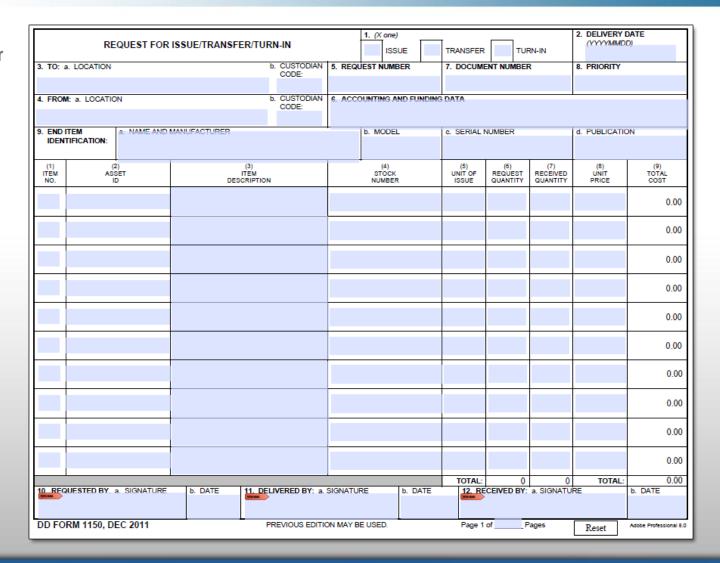

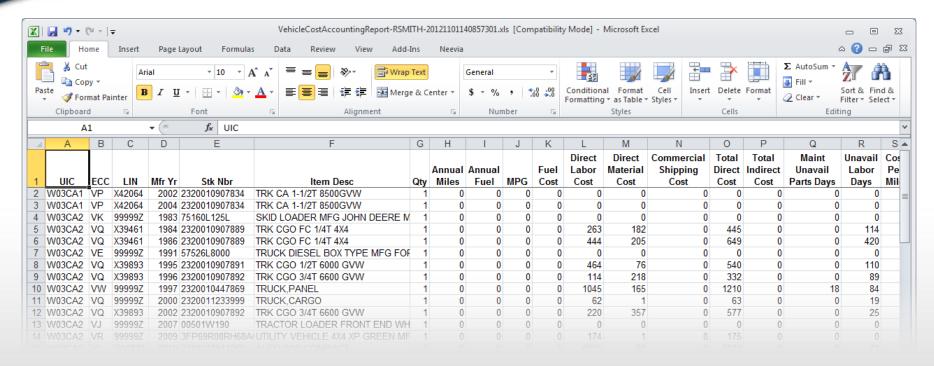
DD1150 Request for Issue or Turn-In Generation –

M&U Statistics





 Vehicle Cost Accounting Report – A new Agency Predefined report. The purpose of this data extract is to provide the user with a listing of non-tactical vehicle accounting and management data with in the Agency.



There were several new statistical inquiries added to support the Dispatch and Work Order/Work Plan functionality that came out in previous releases of DPAS.

- **Dispatch Statistics Inquiry** –statistics for Dispatch, including assets not available for dispatch; average days an asset is dispatch; dispatch category information.
- Utilization Statistics Inquiry -statistics for Utilization, including assets that should report utilization and assets with no utilization reported.
- PM Schedules Statistics Inquiry PM Schedule Statistics collected based on period selected.
- Work Order Statistics Inquiry Work Order Statistics collected based on period selected. Past due, costs, labor hours and generated orders are reported.
- Work Plans Statistics Inquiry Work Plans Statistics collected based on period selected.
